

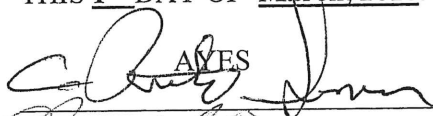
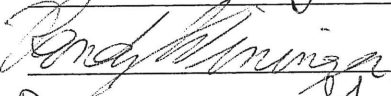
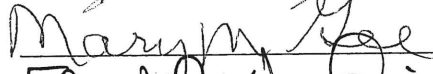
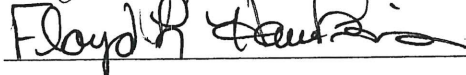
ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget; Now, therefore:

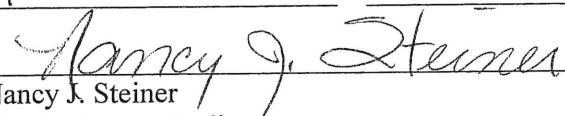

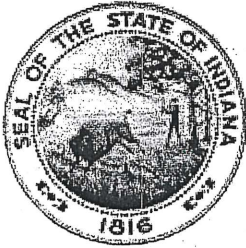

Re: Request for Additional Appropriations from Probation Users Fee Fund

Dear Members of the Martin County Council:

I request the following additional appropriation from the Probation Users Fund:

Capital Expenditures (232,400.14) in the amount \$24,250.00

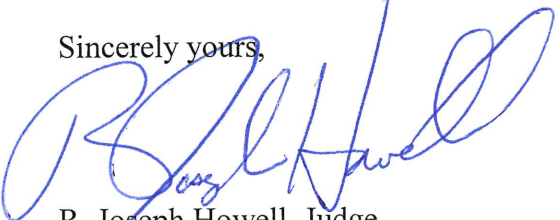
The additional appropriation is requested to enable the Martin County Probation Department to complete the office renovation project that we began in 2009. The Commissioners appropriated \$6,500.00 for the first stage. Alan Street's crew has nearly completed its work, but there is much left to do to make the space safe, efficient, and user-friendly. In light of the existing financial climate, I do not think it is realistic to expect you to appropriate additional taxpayer funds to complete the project. The Users Fee Fund, which is not taxpayer dollars, has a sufficient balance to fund the project.

Time is of the essence. If we proceed before the original project is completed, we can save costs. We also can take advantage of special materials pricing if we act soon. Considering that nothing has been done to the building in the eleven (11) years since the offices moved into the lower level, I do not think this request to spend the non-taxpayer funds now to improve the space is unreasonable.

If you have questions, please contact me in advance of your scheduled meeting. Because the request is fairly self-explanatory, and because of my court schedule, I do not intend to attend your next meeting unless you have some specific questions about these requests. Nevertheless, I hope you will contact me if you have any concerns or questions whatsoever.
