Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana:

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners is responsible for maintaining the Martin County Courthouse and other buildings for the conduct of business with and for the citizens of Martin County by the elected office holders and county employees; and

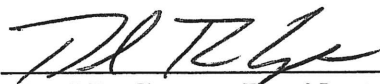
WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners is responsible for maintaining a pleasant and safe location for the conduct of public business;

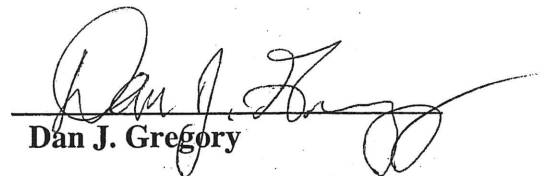
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana, that food preparation for consumption in all buildings maintained by the Board of Commissioners shall be restricted to those foods that may be prepared in microwave ovens, toasters, or in slow-cookers, and

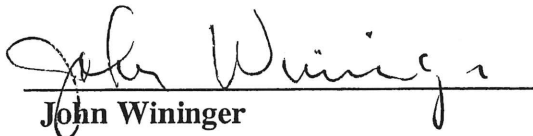
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any foodstuffs, including candy, kept within buildings maintained by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County shall be stored in sealed or sealable metal, rigid plastic, or wooden containers sufficient to withstand pests and to control odors.

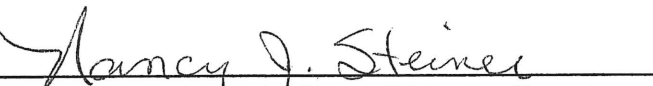
