

MARTIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
RESOLUTION 2011-11

A Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Martin County:

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Martin County does establish a monetary payment to assist Martin County veterans in their travel to medical visits; and it is

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVED that Martin County shall pay travel assistance to veterans in the following amounts:

\$20.00 per visit for Veteran Administration Healthcare facilities 100+ miles.

\$10.00 per visit for Veteran Administration Healthcare facilities 50-100 miles.

The veteran shall present/submit proof of attending the medical visit to the Office of Auditor of Martin County. The Board of Commissioners shall review each claim. Funds for this assistance shall be provided for in the budget of the Veterans Service Officer. The monetary assistance shall not exceed the annual amount as budgeted and approved by the Martin County Council. Payment of this assistance shall be limited to three (3) visits per veteran for the \$20.00 visit and five (5) visits per veteran for the \$10.00 visit.

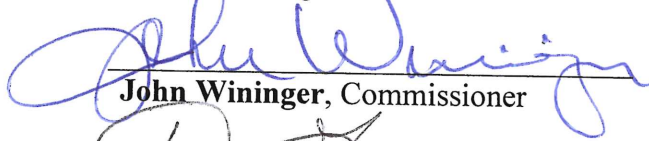
This provision shall become effective September 1, 2011 and shall expire December 31, 2013, or when budgeted funds are expended, whichever event shall occur first.

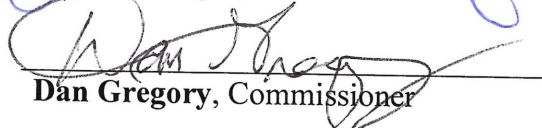

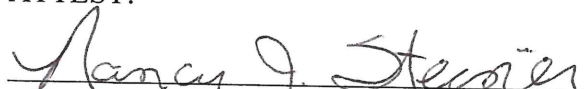
