WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners ("the Board") has given careful study to and recognize that the continued operation of NSA Crane is important to the regional economy and that its future operational capacity should be protected, and

WHEREAS, NSA Crane is interested in preparing a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) to coordinate future planning efforts of its operations and surrounding local governments, and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes that participation in and development of a JLUS will benefit the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of Martin County,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MARTIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

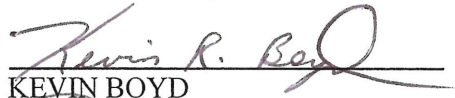
- 1.) The Board agrees to participate in the development of a JLUS for NSA Crane and the surrounding area;
