ORDINANCE NO. 2020- 10

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MARTIN COUNTY CARES FUND

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2020, the Martin County Board of Commissioners did adopt a Resolution requesting reimbursement of payroll expenses in the public health and public safety departments; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana State Board of Accounts has stated that the governing body of a political entity must adopt in a public meeting an ordinance or resolution that the reimbursement of payroll expenses of employees in the public health and public safety departments for the CARES reimbursement received by Martin County from Coronovirus Relief Funds, and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County Indiana, as follows:

- 1. That the Martin County CARES Fund, Fund Number 8901, is hereby established as part of the Martin County General Fund.
- 2. That the Martin County Auditor shall deposit the full reimbursement received in the amount of \$280,382.94 into said CARES Fund and a claim created against said Fund for the full reimbursement amount.
- 3. That the money receipted into said CARES Fund shall be receipted into Martin County General Fund, Fund Number 1000.
- 4. That following receipt into the County General Fund, all normal appropriation procedures shall apply toward said funds.
 - 5. That establishment of said CARES Fund shall be retroactive to November 5, 2020.
