ORDINANCE NO. 2022- 39

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MARTIN COUNTY AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT LOCAL ASSISTANCE AND TRIBAL CONSISTENCY FUND

WHEREAS, the Federal Government has established the Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund as part of Section 9901 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, and

WHEREAS, Martin County has applied for funds from the Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund, and

WHEREAS, Martin County has been awarded Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Funds in the sum of \$100,000.00, of which \$50,000.00 is to be paid in calendar year 2022 and \$50,000.00 to be paid in calendar year 2023, and

WHEREAS, said Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Funds are specified to serve as a general revenue enhancement and may be utilized for any governmental purpose other than a lobbying activity, and

WHEREAS, the Indiana State Board of Accounts requires that a specific fund be established in the Office of the Martin County Auditor for the tracking of grant funds, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County Indiana, as follows:

- 1. That the Martin County American Rescue Plan Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund, Fund Number 8920, is hereby established as part of the Martin County General Fund.
- 2. That the Martin County Auditor shall deposit all funds received by Martin County from the United States Treasury as part of the American Rescue Plan Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund and a claim created against said Fund for the full reimbursement amount.

3. That following receipt into the County General Fund, all normal appropriation procedures shall apply toward said funds.
