ORDINANCE NO. 2022- 40

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MARTIN COUNTY INDIANA CRIMINAL JUSTICE INSTITUTE CORONAVIRUS EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL FUND

WHEREAS, Martin County has received a Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funds grant from the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute in the amount of \$22,850.00 and

WHEREAS, said grant funds were awarded to purchase and install a walk-in freezer/refrigeration unit at the Martin County Security Center, and

WHEREAS, the Indiana State Board of Accounts requires that a specific fund be established in the Office of the Martin County Auditor for the tracking of grant funds, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County Indiana, as follows:

- 1. That the Martin County Indiana Criminal Justice Institute Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Fund, Fund Number 9001, is hereby established as part of the Martin County General Fund.
- 2. That the Martin County Auditor shall deposit all grant funds received by Martin County from the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute as part of the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funds grant and a claim created against said Fund for the full reimbursement amount.
- 3. That following receipt into the County General Fund, all normal appropriation procedures shall apply toward said funds for the purchase and installation of a walk-in freezer/refrigeration unit.
