**A RESOLUTION OF THE MARTIN COUNTY COUNCIL RECOMMENDING
ADOPTING THE 2025 MARTIN COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

WHEREAS, The Martin County Board of Commissioners ("Commissioners ") sought to develop a comprehensive plan to guide future growth and development; and

WHEREAS, community input was gathered through online and in-person meetings, events, and surveys to gather public feedback and gauge public priorities; and

WHEREAS, on November 12th, 2025, the final plan was presented to the Board of Commissioners for adoption; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that the Comprehensive Plan reflects the County's vision, values, and long-term goals for land use, housing, economic development, infrastructure, conservation, and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners further finds that adopting the Comprehensive Plan will support coordinated decision-making, strengthen eligibility for state and federal funding, and provide clear guidance for future development and public investment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana as follows:


1. The Martin County Comprehensive Plan, dated November 12, 2025, is hereby adopted as the official comprehensive plan for Martin County pursuant to Indiana Code 36-7-4.
2. County boards, departments, commissions, and staff are encouraged to use the Comprehensive Plan as a guiding document when making decisions regarding development, infrastructure, land use, capital improvements, and community investment.
3. The County Council supports continued public engagement, collaboration with local communities, and periodic updates to ensure the Plan remains responsive to changing conditions and community needs.




