This notice contains tax bill payment options, answers to common questions, and general county information.

- Tax bills are scheduled to be mailed April 11<sup>th</sup> 2023.
- Tax bills are due Wednesday, May 10<sup>th</sup> and Monday, November 13<sup>th</sup> 2023.
- Tax bills are mailed once per year.
- For a receipt, include a self-addressed stamped envelope with your payment.
- All tax bills are available online at <a href="https://www.co.monroe.in.us/treasurer">www.co.monroe.in.us/treasurer</a>. Click "View Property Tax Information".
- All county offices are closed Friday November 10<sup>th</sup> for Veteran's Day.

All payment options are listed on the reverse side of the tax bill.

Tax rates, assessed value of your home, and exemptions and deductions make up your bill.

- The "Special Message to Property Owner" page compares 2022 to 2023 assessed value and taxes.
- Tax rates for all units went down in 2023. Assessed value is driving most increases in tax bills.
- Assessed value is based on market value. Higher assessed values are affecting all Indiana counties.
- Exemptions and deductions are listed in the "Special Message to Property Owner" page.
- "Other Assessments (OA)" is stormwater fee or liens placed by units.
- "Special" is Solid Waste District, Monroe Fire District, and/or Conservancy District tax.

During this busy time of the year, we are ready to assist with any questions related to your tax bill, your mobile home transfer, fees and collections due in our office, past tax payments and much more.
