

CHAPTER 702

Aircraft Parking Control

702-1. Definitions

“**Aircraft**” shall have the same meaning as defined for that term by IC 8-21-2-1.

“**Director**” shall mean the Airport Director of the Monroe County Airport.

“**Person**” shall mean any individual, firm, corporation, limited liability partnership or limited liability company.

“**Park**” (as related to an aircraft) means any aircraft that is standing or stopped and unoccupied by its pilot.

702-2. Prohibited Parking

No person shall park an aircraft in a location which blocks or impedes ingress and egress to another person's hangar, or which blocks or impedes another aircraft's access to a taxiway.

702-3. Enforcement

- (A) The Airport Director and/or the Monroe County Sheriff may enforce the provisions of this chapter by issuance of a written citation to those persons charged with its violation. Any person issued a written notice of violation of this chapter shall pay the penalty described below to the Monroe County Auditor within seven (7) working days, and such fines shall be deposited in the Monroe County General Fund.
- (B) In lieu of issuing a citation, the enforcement officer may, in his or her discretion, issue an official warning to persons advising them of violation of this chapter, and such warning shall not require payment of the penalty for a subsequent violation of this chapter within one (1) year.
- (C) In the event that the penalty is not paid within the prescribed period, the matter shall be referred to the County Attorney for prosecution.

702-4. Violations

A person who violates this chapter commits a Class D Ordinance violation upon its first occurrence; a person commits a Class C Ordinance Violation upon its second and all subsequent occurrences within one (1) year.
