- 2017 flood was 8.3" higher than 2015.
- In 2017 it has taken 5 weeks for the water to go down.

 This is not just a West Lakes issue with a 117 lakes in Noble County we need to put together a Noble County Lakes Counsel and once that happens, we will be bringing this back to the Commissioners

Since the flood this year we have focused on aid and recovery. A trailer with laundry and water helped. 108 homes were effected from this and 100% of the lake was effected by the sewer shut down.
