Noble County Communications has an opening for a 911 dispatcher. This is a part-time position with varying hours as needed.

DUTIES:

- Receives, dispatches and tracks emergency responses to 911 calls
- Monitors radio frequency activities of various law enforcement and public safety agencies
- Verifies enters and maintains documents and databases for County and other law enforcement agencies.
- Maintains complete and accurate CAD call comments of radio traffic calls
- Completes initial training and annual in-service training as required

JOB REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 18 years of age and have a high school diploma or GED
- Possession of or ability to obtain the maintain all required certifications
- Working knowledge of community geography, maps, emergency code terminology
- Working knowledge of radio frequencies, codes procedures and limitations
- Ability to effectively communicate orally and in writing to co-workers, county departments, various law enforcement agencies and the public
- Ability to maintain confidentiality while providing public access
- Ability to multi-task and work rapidly for long periods of time
- Ability to work extended, irregular, week-ends and holidays and occasionally travel out of town for continued education and training
