JOB OPENING – OPERATOR (RW CLEARING)

Noble County Highway Department has an opening(s) for a full-time operator to oversee brush clearing operations. This is a full-time position with summer/winter varying hours.

DUTIES:

- Operates various trucks and related equipment in clearing, maintaining & repairing County roads.
- Supervises assigned crews, oversees scheduling and making work assignments related to right of way clearing.
- Continually monitors County roads and rights-of-way for existing or potential hazards, reports findings, and schedules improvement projects accordingly.
- Evaluates and inspects tree and brush removal and coordinates all roadside spraying projects.
- Maintains knowledge of long-term County-wide brush clearing and spraying.
- Performs manual labor as required to complete work assignments including chain sawing, brush chipping and lifting and carrying materials and supplies.

REQUIREMENTS

- High School Diploma or GED
- Must be at least 18 years of age and possession of a valid Indiana driver's license and CDL with required endorsements and demonstrate a safe driving record.
- Working knowledge of and ability to make practical application of Department safety policies
- Ability to physically perform assigned duties, including driving for long periods of time, lifting/carrying objects in excess of 50 lbs, and operate various hand and power tools.
- Ability to effectively communicate orally and in writing with co-workers, other County departments and the public.
- Ability to work extended hours, evenings and/or weekends and respond to emergencies from an off-duty status.
- Ability to occasionally serve 24-hour call for emergencies
