## ORDINANCE NO. 2001-

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE SHELBY COUNTY COUNCIL. SHELBY COUNTY, INDIANA AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF A FLAT RATE FOR OFFICERS PARTICIPATING IN A SPECIAL DETAIL ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, the Shelby County Council now finds that the necessity exists to authorize the Shelby County Sheriff to establish a flat rate of compensation for officers who voluntarily participate in "Operation Pullover"; and

WHEREAS, the Shelby County Sheriff receives grants to provide funding for "Operation Pullover" and it is necessary for the Shelby County Sheriff to provide an accounting of the use of said grants in advance of the expenditures which requires the scheduling of officers to perform those duties on a voluntary basis and not as part of their regular employment; and

WHEREAS, for the purposes of scheduling and meeting the accounting requirements it is in the best interests of the Shelby County Sheriff to establish a flat rate of compensation for those officers who volunteer to participate in the special detail assignment ("Operation Pullover"), which is permissible pursuant to the Fair Labor Standards Act;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF SHELBY, as follows:

The Shelby County Sheriff is hereby authorized to establish a flat rate of compensation for officers who voluntarily participate in "Operation Pullover", a special detail assignment, for the purposes of meeting scheduling and accounting requirements.

The Shelby County Sheriff is hereby authorized to establish a flat rate of compensation for officers who voluntarily participate in "Operation Pullover", a special detail assignment, with said rate of compensation to be \$25.00 per hour plus \$1.92 for fringe benefits. The compensation
