ORDINANCE NO. 2009 - 18

AN ORDINANCE to amend the County Thoroughfare and Traffic Code of the County of Shelby, Indiana, by amending Article 2, Chapter 3, Section 2 as it relates to vehicular parking restrictions on Washington Street in Waldron, Indiana in Shelby County, Indiana and to repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

Be it ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Shelby County, Indiana, as follows:

SECTION 1: Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance shall be to restrict all vehicles from parking on Washington Street in Waldron, Indiana, at all times between the intersections of Vine Street and East Street.

SECTION 2: Amendment of County Code. Article 2, Chapter 3, Section 2 of the County Thoroughfares and Traffic Code, referred to as SCC 2-3-2, of Shelby County, Indiana, and the ordinances heretofore adopting said section of the code are hereby amended by adding to SCC 2-3-2 a designation restricting all vehicles from parking on Washington Street in Waldron, Indiana as specified above.

SECTION 3: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Board of Commissioners of Shelby County, Indiana, publication as required by law, and upon the posting of the necessary signs indicating the no parking restrictions at which time it shall be enforceable by all public law enforcement officers in the same manner as the enforcement of

all other provisions of Article 1 of the Shelby County Code.

SECTION 4: Violations. Any person ticketed for violation the no parking restrictions by members of the Shelby County Sheriff's Department shall pay a fee to the Shelby County Clerk at the Shelby County Courthouse in the amount of Ten Dollars (\$10.00). However, if the payment is not made within seventy-two (72) hours of the issuance of the ticket, the fee shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). SECTION 5: Repealable provisions. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the specific amendments herein provided are repealed. Ordinance No. 2005-03 remains in full force and affect.
