Ordinance Creating Health Department Services Fund
Shelby County, Indiana

Whereas: The Shelby County Health Department has provided and may in the future provide various vaccines, clinical testing and other health services to the public at varying costs, and

Whereas: To pay for these vaccines, testing and services, money may be received from insurance providers, the public, or a vaccine provider


NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Shelby County, Indiana that;


The Shelby County Health Department shall establish a fund to be named "Health Department Services Fund".




