

ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 28

AN ORDINANCE to amend the County Thoroughfare and Traffic Code of the County of Shelby, Indiana, by amending Article 2, Chapter 6, Section 2 as it relates to the vehicular traffic on County Road 300 East and East Marion Road and to amend and repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

Be it ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Shelby County, Indiana, as follows:

SECTION 1: Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance shall be to require all vehicular traffic entering the intersection of County Road 300 East and East Marion Road in Shelby County, Indiana specified below to stop at the specifically designated intersection before proceeding through the intersection.

SECTION 2: Amendment of County Code. Article 2, Chapter 6, Section 2 of the County Thoroughfares and Traffic Code, referred to as SCC 2-6-2, of Shelby County, Indiana, and the ordinances heretofore adopting said section of the code are hereby amended by adding to SCC 2-6-2 a designation requiring that all vehicular traffic entering the intersection of County Road 300 East and East Marion Road in Shelby County, Indiana, shall be required to stop before proceeding through the intersection.


SECTION 3: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Board of Commissioners of Shelby County, Indiana, publication as required by law, and upon the posting of stop signs at the entrances of the above specified intersection by the County Highway Superintendent at which time it shall be enforceable by all public law enforcement officers in the same manner as the enforcement of all other provisions of Article 1 of the Shelby County Code.

SECTION 4: Violations. Article 2, Chapter 3, Section 2 of the Thoroughfare and Traffic Code of Shelby County, Indiana, shall be applicable and apply to the enforcement of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: Repealable provisions. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the specific amendments herein provided are repealed.


