## ORDINANCE NO. 2016-17

AN ORDINANCE to amend the County Thoroughfare and Traffic Code of the County of Shelby, Indiana, by amending Article 2, Chapter 5, Section 3 as it relates to the speed limits on certain other county highways and roads.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Shelby County, Indiana, as follows:

SECTION 1: Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance shall be to reduce below the state maximum speed limit the speed at which all vehicular traffic may travel on that portion of Boggstown Road 600 that is between County Road 275 North and Lora Drive.

SECTION 2: Amendment of County Code. Article 2, Chapter 5, Section 3 of the County Thoroughfares and Traffic Code, referred to as SCC 2-5-3, of Shelby County, Indiana, and the ordinances heretofore adopting said section of the code are hereby amended by adding to SCC 2-5-3 a designation restricting all vehicular traffic traveling on Boggstown Road that is between County Road 275 North and Lora Drive to travel at a speed not to exceed thirty (30) miles per hour.

SECTION 3: Substitution of Marked Designation. The following designations shall be added to SCC 2-5-3:

HIGHWAY/ROAD PORTION AFFECTED SPEED LIMIT

Boggstown Road Between County Road 275 30 mph
North and Lora Drive

SECTION 4: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Board of Commissioners of Shelby County, Indiana and upon the posting of speed limit signs at appropriate positions

on Boggstown Road by the County Highway Superintendent, at which time it shall be enforceable by all public law enforcement officers in the same manner as the enforcement of all other provisions of Article 2 of the Shelby County Code.

SECTION 5: Violations. Article 2, Chapter 5, Section 3 of the Thoroughfare and Traffic Code of Shelby County, Indiana, shall be applicable and apply to the enforcement of this ordinance.

<u>SECTION 6:</u> Repealable Provisions. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the specific amendments herein provided are repealed.
