## A RESOLUTION OF THE SHELBY COUNTY COUNCIL, SHELBY COUNTY, INDIANA AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PETTY CASH FUND FOR THE COURTS OF SHELBY COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Shelby County Council now finds that the necessity exists to provide funds for the Courts of Shelby County, Indiana, specifically Shelby Circuit Court, Shelby Superior Court No. 1 and Shelby Superior Court No. 2, for the purposes of jury expenditures; and

WHEREAS, each Court desires to begin their respective petty cash funds with a One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) balance; and

WHEREAS, that it is necessary for the Auditor of Shelby County, Indiana, to establish a petty cash fund for each court with a beginning balance of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF SHELBY, as follows:

The Auditor of Shelby County, Indiana, is authorized to establish a petty cash fund for Shelby Circuit Court, Shelby Superior Court No. 1 and Shelby Superior Court No. 2 with a beginning balance of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), for the purposes of meeting jury expenditures.

Once the respective courts have established their petty cash fund then each court shall submit claims for payments for jury expenditures from said accounts along with actual receipts for said expenditures as they become due and payable in the normal course of business in the payment of claims in Shelby County, Indiana.
