Drain Classification Report- Chase Yanzer: Mr. Yanzer is here requesting the drainage classification report, Don Parker provides it to him and hope this is what he is looking for. The Surveyor's office has gone through the legal drain list and classified each with a corresponding key to show when they would be worked on or the need for work. Mr. Yanzer asks if the list includes all the legal drains in the county? Taylor Sumerford, county surveyor, states it includes all the drains except those not on maintenance. Chris Ross explains that even if a drain is a "county drain" monies are not collected unless it is on maintenance. Mr. Yanzer verifies the list provided today is only drains that funds are being collected on, it is. Mr. Yanzer asks if this list has been adopted by the (Drainage) board? Chris Ross and Kevin Nigh state the board annually approves what ditches stay on or go on maintenance for the year and that has already been done this year. Mr. Yanzer wants to clarify that the report provided is what the drainage board is referring to as the drainage classification report, the board agrees it is. Mr. Yanzer states he also requested the most recent longrange plan. The Drainage Board feels that is covered by the classification report since they are classified by order of importance of work needed. Mr. Yanzer clarifies that this is the only report/ paperwork they have to provide to him, it is. Mr. Yanzer will take the report to look over.

Carmony Tile: Taylor Sumerford, spoke with James Ramsey this morning who advised it is still too muddy to get out and work on this tile but is hoping to be able to this week.

Clendenning Ditch: Taylor Sumerford spoke with Brian Mohr about this ditch, Mr. Mohr has it on his agenda, but weather has not permitted any work yet.

Kevin Nigh notes that someone drove along and/ or in the river and got their truck stuck and dumped some tires off on Little Blue Rd., north of 200 N. He requests the highway department remove the tires from the river.
