Motion to approve minutes from 2/27/2023, Kevin Nigh, 2nd Jason Abel, approved 2/0, Don Parker abstained.

Seifert Drain: David Brown is here regarding an issue with a section of the Seifert Drain that crosses a property he owns as well as 2 other property owners (Jeff Berry & Mrs. Cramer). Mr. Brown had James Ramsey, a local contractor, come look at the tile who believes some trees that are clogging it up. Mr. Ramsey feels replacing a section of the clay tile that crosses Mr. Brown and the 2 other property owners with plastic pipe would be the solution for this. Taylor Sumerford, county surveyor, states this is a very long tile, and it would need some research, possibly by a drainage expert, before doing any work on it. Jason Abel suggests checking on the funding for the drain, and meeting with Mr. Brown, Mr. Ramsey, Taylor and the other property owners to make sure everyone is on the same page, everyone is agreeable.

Alexander Tile: Jason Abel states this drain is in need of some maintenance work. Taylor received a message from a Don Raegan regarding cleaning out this tile, but Taylor has been unable to connect with him at this time. Jason states there is some money in the fund and would like Taylor to get an estimate. Taylor plans to meet with Mr. Raegan first to find out what his specific concerns are.

Jason Abel states he has met with a few residents of the county recently regarding drainage issues throughout, given the amount of rain we've had in the last week. He would like to start educating residents about what the county can and can't do and what their legal obligations are regarding drainage while trying to resolve some drainage issues.
