A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2021 WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA TITLE VI IMPLEMENTATION PLAN IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE TITLE VI CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964

WHEREAS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH **Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964** and associated non-discrimination laws in regards to access to services and activities provided by federal agencies and recipients of federal assistance, the Wabash County Title VI Implementation Plan was drafted to reaffirm the Wabash County's policy to allow all individuals the opportunity to participate in federal financially assisted services: and

WHEREAS, throughout the years, additional regulations and statues, directives, cases and executive orders have been passed which expand the breadth of Title VI: and

WHEREAS, it is a requirement of the Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) and the United States Department of Transportation that communities receiving federal funds adopt a Title VI Implementation Plan: and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Wabash County, Indiana County Commissioners hereby adopts the attached Wabash County Title VI Implementation Plan
