

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2006 85-5

AN ORDINANCE CREATING, AMENDING A SPEED ZONE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana has determined that it would be in the best interest of the general public to cause to be established and/or modified, a speed zone on River Road, beginning at the Wabash City Limits and continuing north approximately 3000 feet to the dead end, a zone wherein the maximum speed for vehicular traffic shall be forty miles per hour (40 mph);

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the advertisement and erection of appropriate signs, the maximum speed limit on River Road north of the Wabash City Limits and continuing north approximately 3000 feet to the dead end shall be forty miles per hour (40 mph) .

Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "A" infraction.
