

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2006 85-8

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana has determined that traffic control signs should be placed at the intersection of Ruth Street and 2nd Street in Urbana, IN; STOP signs will be on eastbound and westbound Ruth Street at intersection of Ruth Street and 2nd, making 2nd Street preferential.

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate STOP signs on eastbound and westbound Ruth Street at intersection of Ruth Street and 2nd, making 2nd Street preferential. The effect of this ordinance shall be to cause traffic traveling east or west on Ruth Street to stop at 2nd Street and proceed only at such time as it is safe and clear to do so.

Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" misdemeanor.
