GENERAL ORDÍNANCE NO. 2005 - TIII

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana has determined that traffic control signs should be placed at the intersection of 200 E and 250 South.

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate STOP signs, all traffic shall be required to stop at the intersection of 200 E and 250 S. The effect of this ordinance shall be to cause traffic coming from any direction to stop and to proceed only at such time as it is safe and clear to do so.

Any person who violates any portion of this ordnance shall be guilty of a Class "C" misdemeanor.
