

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2005-IV

AN ORDINANCE CREATING/AMENDING A SPEED ZONE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana has determined that it would be in the best interest of the general public to cause to be established and/or modified, a speed zone on CR1000S from SR 15 East to CR 390E, a zone wherein the maximum speed for vehicular traffic would be forty miles per hour (40 mph);

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs on CR1000S from SR 15 East to CR390 E, the maximum speed limit shall be forty miles per hour (40 mph).


Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class C Infraction.
