

ORDINANCE 2005- VII

WHEREAS, the use of cellphones and other similar electronic devices used to transmit or receive messages or information have become both necessary and prevalent in modern society; and

WHEREAS, the use of cellphones and other similar electronic devices used to transmit or receive messages or information is disruptive in certain matters, particularly during public proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to reduce and discourage the disruption caused by the use of cellphones and other similar electronic devices used to transmit or receive messages or information in certain public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that:


Cellphones and other similar electronic devices used to transmit or receive messages or information, shall, at all times, be turned off by the person in possession of same, while at the following locations.

- (1) The Wabash Circuit Courtroom and adjacent Hallway;
- (2) The Wabash Superior Courtroom and adjacent Hallway;
- (3) _____.

Person(s) violating this ordinance may be fined in the sum of _____ per violation. Each occurrence shall be deemed a separate violation.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication, as may be required by applicable law.
