## ORDINANCE VACATING PORTION OF COUNTY ROADS

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 8-20-1-1, etc., seq and all other acts amendatory thereof to the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, after petition, notice, and hearing has determined that it would be in the best interest of the residents of Wabash County that the following described portion of County Road be closed, vacated and abandoned;

County Road 950N beginning at County Road 200 W and continuing mostly in a western direction, fording the Eel River and continuing mostly in a westerly direction along and to the south of "Mill Race" where it then connects with what is commonly known and named as County Road 250 W (Troyer Road) on the south side of "Mill Race".

County Road 700 E, said road being nine hundred ninety feet (990) in length beginning at County Road 50 S and continuing south to dead end.

County Road 1300 N beginning at County Road 700 W and continuing west ending at County Road 800 W, Wabash/Fulton County Line.

NOW, THEREFORE, on petition filed, notice, and after hearing and discussion and after due consideration and review, it is determined by the said Wabash County Commissioners as signed hereunder that the following roads or portions thereof, located in Wabash County, be closed, vacated and abandoned;

County Road 950N beginning at County Road 200 W and continuing mostly in a western direction, fording the Eel River and continuing mostly in a westerly direction along and to the south of "Mill Race" where it then connects with what is commonly known and named as County Road 250 W (Troyer Road) on the south side of "Mill Race".

County Road 700 E said road being nine hundred ninety feet (990) in length beginning at County Road 50 S and continuing south until dead end.

County Road 1300 N beginning at County Road 700 W and continuing west ending at County Road 800 W, Wabash/Fulton County Line.

As passed by the Board of Wabash County Commissioners in open meeting on June 30, 2003, and ordinance signed on July 14, 2003.
