GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 1994-9

COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq, and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that there is a need for a stop sign at the intersection of County Road 150W and Division Road, a 3-point intersection. This stop sign would require all southbound traffic on County Road 150W to stop for the intersection of Division Road.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County of Wabash shall be responsible for the placement of the signs.


NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic on the County roads referred to hereinabove, shall be required to stop at the intersection.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to make all traffic traveling South on County Road 150 W to stop at the intersection with Division Road.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.


