SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 85-2, 2009

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF AN ALLEY
IN SERVIA, INDIANA

WHEREAS, there was filed a petition to vacate a portion of an alley and Tanner Street Extended, in Servia, Indiana.

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2008, as required by law and following proper mailing and publication of notice, a public hearing was held on said petition.

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2008, it was deemed by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, to be in the best interests of the County to vacate a portion of the alley as requested, but to deny vacation of Tanner Street Extended.


IT IS NOW ORDAINED THAT THAT PORTION OF AN ALLEY SITUATED ON THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED REAL ESTATE LOCATED IN WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA:


Commencing at the southwest corner of Lot 11 in Faust's Second Addition to the Town of Servia, then east to the southeast corner of said Lot; then south sixteen and one-half feet (16 ½') to the northeast corner of Lot 10 in Faust's Second Addition, then west to the northwest corner of said Lot; then north sixteen and one-half feet (16 ½') to the place of beginning,


IS NOW VACATED.


