GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85-5, 2009

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS
(800N near 400E)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that parking of motor vehicles should be prohibited on the north side of County Road 800 North starting seven hundred thirty feet (730') east of County Road 400 East and continuing for a distance of five hundred thirty feet (530').

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Parking shall be prohibited on the north side of County Road 800 N starting seven hundred thirty feet (730') east of County Road 400 East and continuing for a distance of five hundred thirty feet (530').
2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.


