## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85-10, 2009

## AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS (200 West, US 24 to Division Road, speed limit/school zone)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that the County Road 200 West between U.S. 24 and Division Road should be designated a school zone and the speed limit reduced to thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. County Road 200 West between U.S. 24 and Division Road shall be a school zone and the speed limit shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour.
- 2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C infraction.
- 3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.
