## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85-11, 2009

## AN ORDINANCE REGULATING NOISE

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating noise.

WHEREAS, it is a matter of public policy of this County that the permitting, making and/or creating of loud, unnecessary or unusual noises of various kinds and by various means within the limits of the County constitutes a public nuisance and that that the permitting, making, creation or maintenance of loud, unnecessary, unnatural or unusual noises are a detriment to the public health, comfort, convenience, safety, welfare and prosperity of the residents of the County.

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit, make, continue or cause to be made or continued any loud, unnecessary or unusual noise, or any noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures or endangers the comfort, repose, health and peace or safety of others within the County.
- 2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C infraction.
