

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WABASH COUNTY, INDIANA
GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85-1, 2010
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS
(1400 N, for .4 mile east from 100 W)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that the speed limit on County Road 1400 North for .4 of a mile east from County Road 100 West should be fifteen (15) miles per hour, and that General Ordinance 85-9, 2010 should be amended accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


1. The speed limit on County Road 1400 North for .4 of a mile east from County Road 100 West shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour.
2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.
