

GENERAL ORDINANCE 2002-III

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING SMOKING IN THE
WABASH COUNTY COURTHOUSE, WABASH COUNTY MEMORIAL HALL,
WABASH COUNTY PROBATION DEPARTMENT,
WABASH COUNTY HIGHWAY BUILDINGS, WABASH COUNTY JUDICIAL CENTER,
WABASH COUNTY JAIL and SHERIFF'S BUILDINGS/OFFICES
OR ANY OTHER COUNTY-OWNED FACILITIES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 13-1-13-1 through 13-1-13-9 and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, as follows:

1. There shall be NO SMOKING, meaning the carrying of a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe or any other lighted smoking equipment, or the inhalation or exhalation of smoke from any lighted smoking equipment in any of the County offices, Wabash County Courtrooms, conference rooms, storage rooms, restrooms, halls, furnace room(s) or any other areas of the Wabash County Courthouse, Wabash County Memorial Hall, Wabash County Probation Department, Wabash County Highway Department Buildings, Wabash County Judicial Center, Wabash County Jail (including the Sheriff's buildings/offices), or any other facilities owned by the County of Wabash.
2. Anyone who violates this ordinance commits a Class C infraction.


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after being advertised.
