

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2000 V

AN ORDINANCE CREATING, AMENDING A SPEED ZONE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana has determined that it would be in the best interest of the general public to cause to be established and/or modified, a speed zone on County Road 600 E from County Road 250 S to County Road 500 S, a zone wherein the maximum speed for vehicular traffic would be forty-five miles per hour (45 mph);

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs on County Road 600 E from County Road 250 S to County Road 500 S, the maximum speed limit shall be forty-five miles per hour (45 mph).


Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "B" misdemeanor.

PASSED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indianan, on this 3 day of July, 2000.


