## AMENDED GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 1994-9

## **COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et, seq, and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that there is a need for a stop sign at the intersection of the off-lane between County Road 450 W and County Road 1200 S at the point where said off-lane enters or adjoins 1200 S; meaning that any traffic coming off 450 W, via the off-lane, intending to go on to 1200 S, stops at the point of entry.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County of Wabash shall be responsible for the placement of the signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic on the County roads referred to hereinabove, shall be required to stop at the intersection.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to make all traffic traveling on the off-lane from 450 W onto County Road 1200 S is to stop at the intersection with County Road 1200 S.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
