GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 97- 6

AN ORDINANCE CREATING / AMENDING A SPEED ZONE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code: 8-17-1-1 et seq, and Indiana Code: 9-4-1-1 et seq, and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana has determined that it would be in the best interest of the general public to cause to be established and or modified, a speed zone on County Road 950 South, from State Road 13 to Mississinewa Road wherein the maximum speed for vehicular traffic would be 45 miles per hour (45 mph);

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs on County Road 950 South, from State Road 13 to Mississinewa Road the maximum speed limit shall be $45\,$ miles per hour $(45\,$ mph).

Any person who violates any portion of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "B" misdemeanor.
