AMENDED GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9

COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that there is a need for the intersection of County Road 1400 N. and County Road 100 W. to be changed from a yield to a stop sign. This would require all traffic going East or West on County Road 1400 N. to stop for the intersection of County Road 100 W. making 100 W. Preferential at this intersection with 1400 N.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County of Wabash shall be responsible for the placement of the signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic on the County roads referred to hereinabove, shall be required to stop at the intersection.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to make all traffic traveling East or West on County Road 1400 N. to stop at the intersection of County Road 100 W.

Any person who violate's any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
