## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 96-1

## AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING VACATION OF PORTION OF PLATED ALLEYWAY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code, and all other acts amendatory thereof of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, after careful consideration, investigation, and for cause determined find that it would be in the best interest of Wabash County that the following described portion of previously vacated alley under General Ordinance # 92-11 be revoked, and said area restored to platted consideration;

Alleyway between lots #95, #96, #77 and #78, being a distance of 120 feet, more or less, in the original Comstock Plot (Platt) of Liberty Mills, Chester Township, Wabash County, Indiana. The area also located as on the northwest and southwest corner of Third Street, between Wall and Wabash Streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, when reconsideration and for good cause it is hereby ordained that the following portion of previously vacated alleyway be restored to platt and Ordinance # 92-11 be rescinded;

Alleyway between lots #95, #96, #77 and #78, being a distance of 120 feet, more or less, in the original Comstock Plot (Platt) of Liberty Mills, Chester Township, Wabash County, Indiana. The area also located as on the northwest and southwest corner of Third Street, between Wall and Wabash Streets.
