## ORDINANCE NO. 96-3

## ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COUNTY CORRECTIONS FUND

Whereas, SEA 395, (1986) added 11-12-6 to the Indiana Code to provide for establishment of a county corrections fund; and

Whereas, I.C. 11-12-6-6 provides that a county legislative body may annually adopt an ordinance to elect to receive deposits from the State Department of Corrections to establish a county correction fund; and

Whereas, the county correction fund may be used only for funding the operation of the county jail or jail programs, and

Whereas, the county legislative body may elect to receive deposits at either Level 1, Level 2, or Level 3 funding; and

Whereas, Level 3 is most appropriate level of participation for Wabash County; therefore:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WABASH COUNTY

## that:

- Section 1. a county corrections fund is established for Wabash County;
- Section 2. the legislative body elects to receive deposits from the State Department of Corrections to be deposited in the Wabash County Corrections Fund; and
- Section 3. said county corrections fund shall only be used for funding the operations of the county jail or jail programs; and money remaining in the county corrections at the end of the year does not revert to any other fund but remains in the county corrections fund.
- Section 4. the county legislative body elects to receive deposits at Level 3 funding from the State Department of Corrections;
