GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9

COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that there is a need for stop sign to be placed at the intersection of the Water Works Road and Meridian Road. The sign would require traffic going East on Water Works Road to stop for Meridian Road; and


WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County of Wabash shall be responsible for the placement of the sign.


NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate sign, all traffic on the County roads referred to hereinabove, Water Works road at its intersection with Meridian Road shall flow as follows: All East bound traffic on Water Works Road shall stop for preferential traffic on Meridian Road.


Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
