GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9

COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that there is a need for the intersection of County Road 390 E. and County Road 900 S. to be changed to a four way stop. This would require all traffic going East & West on County Road 900 S. and all traffic going North & South on County Road 390 E. to stop at that intersection.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County of Wabash shall be responsible for the placement of the signs.


NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic on the County roads referred to hereinabove, shall be required to stop at the intersection.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to make all traffic traveling East & West on County Road 900 S. and all traffic going North & South on County Road 390 E. to stop at that intersection.


Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.

PASSED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, this 7<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1996.


