AN ORDINANCE REVOKING ORDINANCE NO. 87-1


BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code, and all other acts amendatory thereof to the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, after reconsideration, investigation, and for cause find and determine that it would be in the best interest of all residents of Wabash County that the following described previously passed ordinance be revoked. That being General Ordinance No. 87-1 entitled an Ordinance Revoking Prior Actions and Establishing Rules and Regulations for Applying for and Designating Economic Revitalization Areas as Provided by IC 6-1.1-12.1-1 Through 6-1.1-12.1-5.7 as Amended. Said ordinance having been passed by the Wabash County Commissioners on January 12, 1987.




