AMENDED GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9

COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that there is a need for a yield sign to be placed at the intersection of Golf Course Drive and Gardens Drive, causing all traffic traveling on Golf Course Drive toward the intersection with Gardens Drive to yield at said intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic on Golf Course Drive travelling toward the intersection of Gardens Drive, shall be required to yield at said intersection, and said traffic shall proceed only at such time as it is safe to do so.

Further, it shall be the responsibility of the County of Wabash for the placement of a yield sign of said Golf Course Drive and Gardens Drive crossing intersection.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to make all traffic traceling on Golf course Drive toward the intersection with Gardens Drive to yield.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
