GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9

COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that there is a need for the intersection of County Road 700 S. and County Road 390 E. to be changed from a yield to a stop sign. This would require all traffic going East & West on County Road 700 S. to stop at the intersection of County Road 390 E, making County Road 390 E. Preferential at this intersection with County Road 700 S.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County of Wabash shall be responsible for the placement of the signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic on the County roads referred to hereinabove, shall be required to stop at the intersection.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to make all traffic traveling East & West on County Road 700 S. to stop at the intersection of County Road 390 E.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
