GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9

COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq. and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq. and all acts amendatory thereto of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that there is a need for stop sign to be placed at the intersection of Gardens Drive and Division Road. The sign would require traffic going South on Gardens Drive to stop for Division Road; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County of Wabash shall be responsible for the placement of the signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate signs, all traffic on the County roads referred to hereinabove, shall be required to stop at the intersection.

The effect of this Ordinance shall be to make all traffic traveling on South on Gardens Drive to stop at the intersection of Division Road.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
