## GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-5

## AN ORDINANCE APPROVING INMATE MEDICAL CO-PAYMENTS

BE IT ORDAINED by The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under authority of Indiana Code 11-12-5-5 as follows:

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana are informed of their right to approve inmate medical copayments during their time of incarceration in the Wabash County Jail; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana after careful review, consideration, and full understanding feel that it is in the best interest of the County, inmates, and general public for such approval to be granted.

NOW THEREFORE, The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, as signed hereunder do hereby accept and approve participation by Wabash County, through the Wabash County Sheriff's Department in the Inmate Medical Co-payment Plan outlined and established by Indiana Code 11-12-5-5.

FURTHER, the Wabash County Sheriff's Department is directed to implement this program on the effective beginning date thereof July 1, 1994.
