GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 1, 2012

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS (Cooper Road, Mill Creek Pike to 700 West, speed limit)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, have determined that the speed limit on Cooper Road between Mill Creek Pike and 700 West should be reduced to forty-five (45) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The speed limit on Cooper Road between Mill Creek Pike and 700 West shall be forty-five (45) miles per hour.
- 2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C infraction.
- 3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signage in accordance with this Ordinance.
