GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 93-7

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF PARKING CONTROL SIGNS

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, under the authority of Indiana Code 8-17-1-1 et. seq., and Indiana Code 9-4-1-1 et. seq., and all acts amendatory thereof of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, have determined that parking limitations are necessary and in the best interest of the public on both sides of County Road 550 West, also known as Mill Creek Pike, beginning at the North edge of State Numbered Bridge 13 and proceeding North for a distance of approximately 900 feet along either guardrail.

NOW THEREFORE, from and after the erection of appropriate No Parking Signs, there shall not be any parking allowed on either side of County Road 550 West, also known as Mill Creek Pike, beginning at the North edge of State Numbered Bridge 13 and proceeding North for a distance of approximately 900 feet along either guardrail.

The effect of this ordinance shall be to create a No Parking Area in the area described.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class C Infraction.
